2026 SUPERCONTEST COLLEGE FOOTBALL CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

The "2026 SuperContest College Football Contest" (hereinafter the "SuperContest College", "Contest" or "Promotion") refers to the events commencing Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 9:00 AM and ending on Saturday, November 28, 2026 (pending no games are in delay per rule 23). ("Promotional Period") at the Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino ("Sponsor") located at 3000 Paradise Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89109. All references to time of day contained herein refer to Las Vegas, Nevada time.

1. All contestants and proxies must be at least 21 years of age to participate. Contestants must provide valid proof of age that is acceptable to the SuperBook (driver's license, current passport, or state identification card), which may act in its sole and absolute discretion as it deems appropriate. If contestant is not a U.S. resident, a current passport or alien registration card is required.
2. All contestants must have a Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino WOW rewards card. Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino WOW cards are free and are available at the WOW Rewards Center or the casino cage.
3. Contestants can participate in the SuperContest College by paying a fee of \$500 per entry. Entry fees are valid through weeks 1 - 13 of college football regular season and are non-refundable. Method of payment includes cash, cashier's check, money order, Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino live gaming chips and credit card. No personal checks will be accepted. All cashier's checks and money orders must be made out to Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino. Debit/Credit cards are subject to a 3% surcharge.
4. Entry fees will begin being accepted for the SuperContest College Football Contest at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 1, 2006, and conclude at 3:00 PM Friday, September 4, 2026.
5. Maximum of ten (10) entries per contestant. Each entry shall be treated as a separate entry for all purposes, including prize distribution. The SuperBook reserves the right to approve all aliases (limited to 20 characters/no commas). SuperBook management has the right to change any alias name for any reason.
6. The SuperContest College will begin Thursday, September 3, 2026, and conclude on Saturday, November 28, 2026 (provided no games are in delay per rule 23).
7. The SuperContest College is based on selecting winning teams against the SuperBook contest line. Contestants must select seven (7) college football teams per entry, per week from the NCAAF contest menu. Contestants may not select both sides of the same game on a single entry. In the event a contestant has multiple entries they may select one side of the game on one (1) entry and the opposite side of the same game on any other entry.
8. Contest winners will be determined by the total number of points accumulated during weeks 1 - 13 of the college football season. Each winning selection against the point spread will count as one (1) point. Ties (pushes) against the point spread count as one half (1/2) point. In the event of an NCAAF team forfeiting a game, the winning team will be awarded one (1) point and the forfeiting team will be awarded zero (0) points. **This rule does NOT apply to games that are canceled and/or postponed.**
9. Weekly selection sheets will be available at approximately 5:00 PM each Wednesday during the promotional period. Contestant weekly selections will be available in the SuperBook Friday evening. Current standings will be available in the SuperBook each Monday afternoon (Week 1 will be Tuesday). Current standings and selections may be available on WestgateLasVegas.com for information purposes only. The SuperBook shall not be responsible for any errors and/or misinformation on its website. Official standings and selections are only available in The SuperBook.
10. Each contestant may authorize a proxy to submit their weekly selections by properly signing and authorizing such. Both contestant and proxy must sign-up, in person, at the same time in The SuperBook or designated signup location. The SuperBook is not responsible for any contestant being unable to submit his/her picks for any reason. It is the responsibility of each contestant to reach an understanding with his/her proxy service for a contingency plan on submitting picks if any issues arise.
11. Contestants/proxies will be required to swipe their SuperBook Contest ID card at The SuperBook self-service contest window to make their selections. By signing the official entry form, the entrant becomes the "official contestant" and is the **only** one approved to collect any prize monies. Proxies are **not** eligible to collect any prize monies. Contestants may share winnings by filling out IRS Form 5754 (Statement by Person(s) Receiving Gambling Winnings) once the SuperContest College winners become official. Prize money must be collected within 90 days of contest becoming official.
12. **Contestants must submit their weekly selections at The SuperBook between each Wednesday when contest lines are available (approx. 5:00 PM) and 5:00 PM each Friday. In the event a contestant wishes to use any game that starts before this 5:00 PM Friday deadline their weekly selections must be submitted prior to the start of those games. Contestant(s) who fail to submit their weekly selection by 5:00 PM every Friday will be awarded zero (0) points that week. DEADLINE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
13. SuperContest College contestants will be able to submit their weekly selections via the SuperContest mobile app. **Mobile selections must be submitted during each week of the 2026 contest period by Friday at 5:00 PM pacific time via the SuperContest mobile app.** Contestants/Proxies must be within the approved geographic boundary to make mobile selections. The SuperBook is not responsible for any technical difficulties, malfunctions or any predictable or unforeseen issues regardless of whether the issues are on the end of the SuperBook app or the contestant/proxy. Each contestant is therefore responsible for submitting his/her picks over the counter before the 5:00 PM Friday deadline if they are unable to do so via the mobile app. Receipts on the SuperContest contest app will be in the form of a digital confirmation screen (complete with unique identifying confirmation code which is a 12-digit electronic ticket serial number) reflecting selections made, and such receipts represent the official entry of record for the entrant's weekly selections. Entrants are encouraged to screenshot the confirmation screen when it appears just after selection submission through the app which will have the 12-digit ETSN number. No other documents provided to SuperBook shall be considered official record of weekly selections.

14. The selection ticket (receipt) generated by The SuperBook computer system is the official weekly entry of record. The contestant's official selections will be those contained in The SuperBook computer system records. If a selection ticket is not produced via the self-service contest window the contestant/proxy must notify a SuperBook Supervisor immediately to receive a printed copy of their weekly selections. The "selection sheet" itself is not an official entry of record.
15. Weekly selections are only submitted once per contest entry. Contestants/proxies cannot void weekly selections after the SuperBook retail counter closes on the day they are submitted. Weekly SuperContest College selection ticket void requests must be submitted to a SuperBook Supervisor for approval. In the event a contestant has multiple entries; a contestant/proxy must submit separate weekly selections for each entry. If more than one (1) weekly selection is erroneously accepted for an entry, the first entry of weekly selections associated with that entry will be the official selections of record.
16. **SuperContest College Prize Structure**
All percentages based on entry fees. Prize pool consists of all entry fees and may change based on respective places.
17. Contestants tying will equally split aggregate prize money for the respective place.
18. The college football regular season must consist of 10 (ten) weeks for the SuperContest College to be considered valid. If the regular season is shortened to less than 10 weeks the SuperContest College will be cancelled, and all entry fees will be refunded.
19. All SuperBook House Rules apply to this contest unless otherwise stipulated in these rules.
20. The SuperBook reserves the right to cancel this contest or refuse to accept any registration or wager if the same could violate any federal, state or county law, ordinance, or regulation. Furthermore, the SuperBook may cancel the contest in the event of technical difficulties or other occurrences beyond the control of The SuperBook.
21. Selections may be accepted manually in case of a computer system failure, or other unforeseen circumstances as deemed necessary by SuperBook management.
22. Entry fees will not be refunded for reasons other than the cancellation of the SuperContest College.
23. For contest purposes, all games are action despite a location change. In the event of a game cancellation or postponement, the game must be played by 11:59 PM Monday of the current week to be applied toward contest standings or contestant will be awarded .5 (1/2) point for that game if selected.
24. After the final winners are posted on Monday, November 30, 2026, a three (3) day verification period will occur. Any disputes with the contest and results or prize allocation must be provided to management in writing within this verification period. At the end of the three (3) day verification period, the SuperContest College results will be declared official, and payout will be awarded Friday, December 4, 2026. Payouts can be transferred into a contestants Mobile Wagering Account by providing SuperBook management proper documentation. In the event of a dispute, the decision of management is final.
25. Key employees, as well as family members of the SuperBook, may not participate or serve as a proxy in the SuperContest College.
26. All contestants agree to grant The SuperBook unconditional use of their name and likeness for promotion as/advertising and announcements without compensation, consideration, notice review or consent.
27. All decisions regarding the interpretation of rules, eligibility, etc. for this promotion lie solely with The SuperBook whose decisions are final.
28. All contest times are approximate. The SuperBook reserves, in full, all rights in enforcing any time deadlines and the SuperBook's decision will be final.
29. All entries are subject to review and verification.
30. The SuperBook reserves the right to modify or cancel this contest at any time for any reason, subject to any applicable regulatory approval provided that such modification shall not, as the date of such modification, materially alter or change any participant's prize already awarded.
31. The SuperBook may disqualify any person for any prize based upon belief of the possible commission of fraud, dishonest, violation of contest rules or other misconduct whether or not related to this contest.
32. Record of entries will be retained for record keeping purposes in accordance with legal requirements.
33. Individuals who are excluded from casino facilities, including through a government program, at the Superbook discretion, or by their own request, are not eligible to participate, win any prize, or receive a refund.
34. A copy of these rules and any changes will be available at the SuperBook throughout the duration of this contest.
35. All laws and regulations of the Nevada State Gaming Commission and Gaming Control Board apply.
